As you consider all of your options during this important time, please know that we are committed to maintaining an open adoption and value the tremendous importance of a child's first family throughout their life.

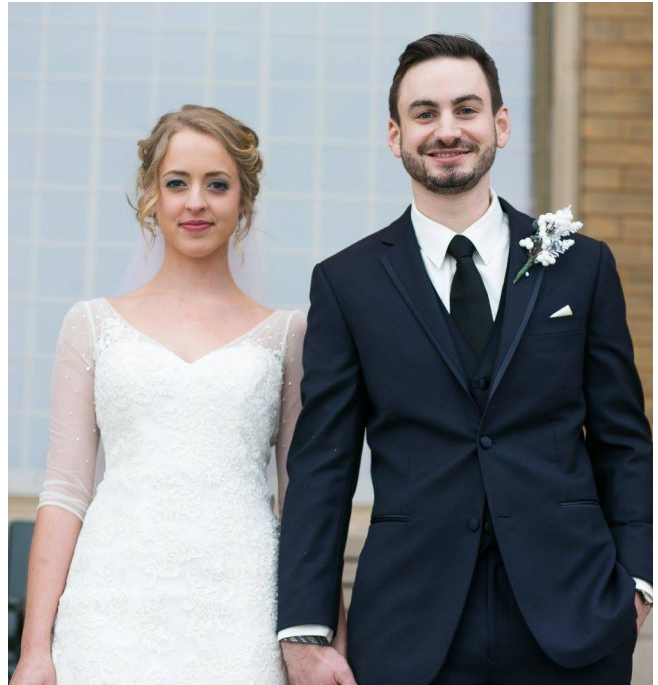
